### Man suspected of cow smuggling killed...

to his village along with another man when they were stopped by a group of villagers near Lalawandi village in Alwar. They were brutally thrashed, the office of Additional Director General Jaipur Range, Ramgarh, received this information at 12.40 am.

When the police team reached the spot they found an injured Khan lying in the mud. Two persons were standing there with two cows, ADGP Hemant Priyadarshi told the media. Khan told the officers that he and his companion Aslam had purchased the cows from Ladpur and were on their way to their village when they were mistaken for cow smugglers and attacked. "My limbs are broken," said Khan covered in mud before collapsing. He was immediately rushed to a hospital, where he was declared brought dead. His body was sent for autopsy. The police in Ramgarh registered a case against unidentified persons under several sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Police have arrested Dharmendra Yadav and Paramjit Singh Sardar who were found on the spot standing with bovines. Further probe is on. Alwar has earlier also witnessed attacks in the name of cow protectionism.

The latest killing comes more than a year after Pehlu Khan was murdered allegedly by some cow vigilantes in April 2017. The central and state governments came under a sharp criticism from the Supreme Court earlier this week over frequent lynching incidents. The Supreme Court also asked Parliament to come up with a law to tackle cow vigilantism and lynching, calling such incidents "horrendous acts of mobocracy" that should be nipped in the bud.

Cases of mob fury have been on a rise in India. According to the Ministry of Home Affairs, 45 persons were killed by mob in 40 cases across nine states between 2014 and March 03 this year.

was able to bring him home. My brother had sustained physical injuries to his head, hands, legs and back after having been thrashed with a baton and being assaulted bare-handed by five policemen.

"The complainant, who had registered the mobile theft offence, had also visited my house on July 13. Despite the complainant informing police at the identification parade that it was not my brother who had conducted the robbery, police illegally detained him. Another 17-year-old youth, K Ali, too was picked up by police from the Dharavi area. He had also sustained injuries but his condition was stable. Ali and my brother were both released at the same time. There are no offences registered against my brother at any police station."

Sunil says Sachin was barely able to walk and was unconscious, so he took the latter to a private clinic right after leaving the police station. Since his condition worsened, he was rushed to Lokmanya Tilak Hospital, Sion, on July 15, where he was in the general ward for 12 hours and later on shifted to the hospital's ICU. He died late on Saturday night.

"On July 18, we submitted a letter to Rajeev Jain, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Zone 5) seeking an inquiry into the incident. We have also submitted a letter to the Chief Secretary at Mantralaya with the help of the Bahujan Samaj Party. The DCP has promised us verbally that necessary action will be taken against the officers and he is likely to issue a suspension order on Monday," added Sunil.

According to Suresh Patil, senior police inspector; Dharavi police station, "Sachin was called for questioning in a mobile theft case. But since we did not find his involvement in the case, he was released. He does not have any previous criminal records registered against him. However, he has developed leptospirosis and has a drinking problem, due to which he has developed kidney and liver infection. So, he has been admitted to the hospital after two-to-three days of questioning. We have not assaulted him or illegally detained him. However, an inquiry is being conducted in this matter by the DCP."

Despite repeated calls and text messages, DCP Rajeev Jain remained unavailable for comment. A rally was earlier conducted at Dharavi by BSP workers on Saturday to protest against the incident.

### 19-year-old gets death for raping a toddler

to abduction of minor and 376 AB (for rape on woman under 12 years of age) and 5(M)/6 of POCOS Act. The death penalty was awarded under the IPC section 376 AB, SHO of the Laxmangarh police station Prahlad Sahay said.

It is the first such case in Rajasthan after the criminal law (amendment) ordinance, which introduced IPC Section 376 AB came into force on April 21 this year under which the provision of death penalty for raping a girl below 12 years of age was introduced, according to DGP OP Galhotra.

"The local police had filed a challan against Pintu under sections of POCOS Act and IPC on June 6," IG Jaipur Hemant Priyadarshi said. The ordinance was brought in after the outcry over the gangrape and murder of an eight-year-old girl in Kathua in Jammu and Kashmir.

# TV, refrigerator, washing machines to get cheaper, GST rate cut on 50 items

In a relief for common man, the GST Council on Saturday reduced tax rates on over 50 items including refrigerators, washing machines and small televisions, which would now be taxed at 18 per cent, down from the current 28 per cent.

Apart of bringing down rates, the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Council also exempted GST on sanitary napkins, rakshis, fortified milk and idols of deities made of stone, marble and wood, reports IANS.

The changes would come into effect across the country from July 27 onward, Finance Minister Piyush Goyal told media after the 28th meeting of the GST Council.

"Refrigerators, small televisions, of upto 25 inches, lithium ion batteries, vacuum cleaners, domestic electrical appliances, such as food grinders, mixers...storage water heaters, immersion heaters, hair dryers, hand driers, electric smoothing irons," among others have been brought to the 18 per cent slab," Goyal said. The council also gave a major relief to the hotel industry by providing that tax rate shall be based on transaction value instead of declared tariff.

Earlier, there was a lack of clarity on the issue causing a

lot of trouble for consumers booking hotels with 'declared tariffs' of Rs 7,500 and above which incurred 28 per cent GST.

While hotels with tariff below Rs 1,000 are exempted from GST, those with tariff between Rs 1,000-2,500 are taxed at 12 per cent, those between Rs 2,500-7,500 at 18 per cent, and above Rs 7,500 at 28 per cent.

However, it often happened that hotels offered discounts and hence the actual transaction cost would be much lower than the declared cost, but tax would still be charged at

the declared cost. The council also deferred the implementation of reverse charge mechanism by another year and now it will come into force from October next year.

The minister further informed that the council would have a special meeting on August 4 to address concern of small and medium enterprises.

Among other tax-reduction decisions, Goyal said, tax rate on handicraft items such as handbags, pouches and purses, jewellery box, wooden frames of paintings and photographs among others have been brought under the 12 per cent slab, from 18 per cent.

GST on handmade carpets and handmade textile floor coverings has been reduced from 12 per cent to 5 per cent.

## 60,000 Indian youth detained along US-Mexico border: Manish Tewari

Senior Congress leader and former Union minister Manish Tewari on Saturday claimed that 60,000 Indian youth, a substantial number of them from Punjab, were detained at the detention camps along the US-Mexico border.

He said he had personally visited the border area during his recent US visit and was alarmed by the situation there, reports PTI.

Addressing a party workers' meeting organised by Punjab Congress secretary Satwinder Jawaddi here, Tewari said that he was told during his visit that 60,000 In-

dians, who had tried to sneak illegally into the US through Mexico, had been detained by the US authorities.

"Of these, over ninety per cent are Punjabis," he added. Expressing concern over the plight of these stranded youth, Tewari said their release has to be dealt at the level of the Ministry External Affairs and he had already raised the matter.

He added that Punjab also needed to create job avenues for the youth.

Speaking about the Congress' prospects for the upcoming Lok Sabha elections, the former Ludhiana MP said that the "countdown" of the NDA government had started.
